PA 94-0600: During each academic year, schools must conduct a minimum of 3 school evacuation drills to address and prepare students and school personnel for fire incident. One of the 3 school evacuation drills shall require the participation of the appropriate local fire department or district. During each academic year, schools must conduct a minimum of one bus evacuation drill. During each academic year, schools must conduct a minimum of one severe weather and shelter-in-place drill to address and prepare students and school personnel for possible tornado incidents and may conduct additional severe weather and shelter-in-place drills to account for other incidents, including without limitation earthquakes or hazardous materials.

PA 95-1015: During each academic year, schools must conduct one law enforcement drill in accordance with the schools current emergency and crisis plans. The drill may be done on days when students are not present. P.A. 98-0048 Law enforcement drill shall include a school shooting incident and must be held even if the school and law enforcement cannot agree on a date.
