Scholarship Opportunities for Students

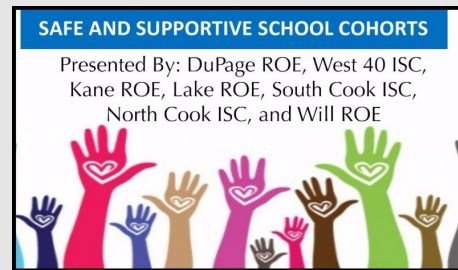
