### U-46's New Beginnings Regional Safe School Cooperative Education Program (RSSCEP)

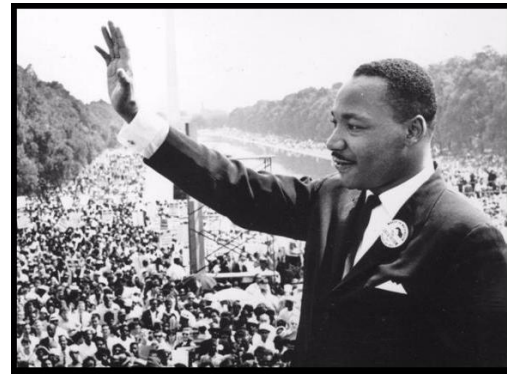
This December, U-46's New Beginnings RSSCEP had a graduating class of four students. The New Beginnings RSSCEP is a partnership between the ROE and U-46 to offer a broader range of educational supports to help students meet Illinois Learning Standards and complete their education in a safe learning environment. The program began during the 2015-2016 school year with grant supports from the Illinois State Board of Education.



The New Beginnings RSSCEP focuses on helping students overcome graduation challenges through working in compliance accords with the ROE. The program allows participants to complete their diploma while also learning important job related skills. This work cooperative provides students with the opportunity to gain work experience in interested career paths.
